



Simplified Judging 2018-2019 Pilot New Mexico FLL Qualifiers

Simplified Judging – **CHANGES** – please note!

Our region is participating in a pilot of a simplified Judging approach at all NM FLL Qualifiers for the 2018-2019 INTO ORBITSM season.

Due to scheduling considerations the single judging session is CANCELLED.

~~During the morning, each team will participate in **one (1) 30 minute judging session**. Bring **all** relevant judging materials to the session.~~

- ~~• There will be 6 Judges in the room – 2 Judges from each of the 3 areas.~~
- ~~• Teams will be asked to give a 5 minute presentation for each of the 3 areas –~~
- ~~• Q&A – after the presentations, there will be a **15 minute Q&A**, with ~5 minutes for each of the areas~~
- ~~• Each pair of the Judges will complete the relevant rubric for their area.~~

During the morning, each team will participate in the usual 3 separate judging sessions (2 judges each) with the following format

- **Project – 10 minutes**
 - 5 minutes – standard presentation (see the Challenge guide)
 - 5 minutes - Q&A
- **Robot Design – 10 minutes**
 - 5 minutes - presentation of the Robot Design Summary worksheet (replaces the Robot Design Executive Summary)
 - There will NOT be a full robot game table, just a small image of the game table which teams may use to explain robot missions
 - 5 minutes - Q&A
- **Core Values – 10 minutes**
 - 5 minutes - presentation of the Core Values Poster - Follow the Pilot Core Values Poster-Qualifier guidelines
 - NO teamwork activity
 - 5 minutes - Q&A
